PROJECT DESCRIPTION / SUMMARY

A picture speaks a thousand words - and this remains true as we notice the emerging passion for photography among youngsters. When words fail to express, memories become dim, pictures are the only way to capture a moment that is gone forever and impossible to reproduce.

'Let's Snap!' project aims to document our life through photographs. Students will get to know about each other's life and learn about the diverse culture through the sharing of photos. Since the Project would use online platforms such as PhotoBlog and Facebook, students will get an opportunity to view and comment on each other's wall. This is how the students from Asia & Europe will use an ICT based common platform for communication.

- Encourage appreciation of one's ethnicity and cultural heritage.
- Engage the student participants in authentic learning and creative thinking.

- Help forge lasting friendships and understanding amongst students.

Expected Outcome

Tangible

- Students to create photo collages online and share with their friends
- Students to create photo cards and send it to new friends made through the project

Intangible

- Increase students' awareness of other countries' cultures
- Increase students' proficiency in English
- Improve students' skills and knowledge in ICT

Phase 1 (January 2016)

- Set-up Facebook group and invite members to the group
- Self-introduction by all participating members
- Students to create a photo blog

Phase 2 (February to May 2016)

- Students to update their photo blog, following the theme of the month:
 - My Family Tree
 - What Puberty Did To Me
 - My School Life
 - My Favourite Pastime
 - Places of Interest in My Country

Phase 3 (June 2016)

- Participants and teachers to share their reflections and learning points from the project.

- Write a self-portrait to introduce themselves.
- Present the information on the ICT project platform.
- Attend online discussions and interact with other participants through the use of communication tools available on the ICT platform.
- Participate in an online feedback session.
- Share their experiences, problems faced and reflect on the project, their sharing and the collaboration with partners from other countries
