PROJECT DESCRIPTION / SUMMARY

TIMELINE AND PHASES OF THE PROJECT

Phase 1 (December 2015)

Set up Facebook group and invite members to the group.

- Self-introduction by all participating members

Phase 2 (January toMay2016)

- Research and share about the livelihood, food habits, attire, religious beliefs, festivals, dances and art forms of the tribal people.
- Present day difficulties faced by the tribes. Their adjustment problems in the modern society.
- Their inability to accept change and different government programmes initiated for their upkeep.
- Students to share their personal opinions about their understanding of the tribes.

Phase 3 (June -July 2016)

- A comparative study by the students would be done to highlight the similarity and differences of the various tribes discussed.
- Feedback and evaluation session

- Share photos and videos with description on ICT project platform.
- Generate discussions on the similarities and differences of the tribal cultures in Europe and Asia.
