PROJECT DESCRIPTION / SUMMARY

This project focuses on the effects and consequences of mass migration. During the course of the project the participants will have discussions regarding aspects related to mass migration. The project aims to raise awareness on subjects related to it. The participants will look at different viewpoints of the subject, discuss possible reasons and consequences of (mass) migration, interview experts, and make presentations on the topic. The students will also watch different videos on the issue, and compare their ideas and views, and see similarities and differences between Asia and Europe. A project Facebook group will be set up for posts and discussions.
